

Autodesk Certified User AutoCAD Exam

Best Practices

Overview:

The Autodesk Certified User AutoCAD exam has been completely reworked to provide you and your students a good experience taking the exam. Some key points:

- Exam no longer limits students to 3 clicks to answer the question. The interface provides an environment similar to what the person taking the exam would encounter in their CAD lab.
- The AutoCAD interface for the exam is delivered over the internet. This has been greatly improved.
 - Some of the questions allow the student to enter commands from the Command Line.
- The exam is 40 minutes and is timed.
 - You can mark questions for review.
 - Timer is displayed
 - Question Tracker appears on screen.
- 25 questions
 - 8 Questions are multiple choice
 - These are fair and reasonable questions
 - 17 questions test the ability of the person taking the exam to use the software
- Exam is applicable to schools using AutoCAD 2010, 2011, or 2012, and is not version specific
 - Person taking the exam will be provided with a score and an analysis of how they scored on the sectors tested. See **Exhibit B Using AutoCAD Examination Score Report**
 - Students will receive a certificate if they pass the exam.

Preparation for Taking Exam

- The test taker must be proficient in the use of the software and have a minimum 120 hours of instruction in AutoCAD before taking the exam.

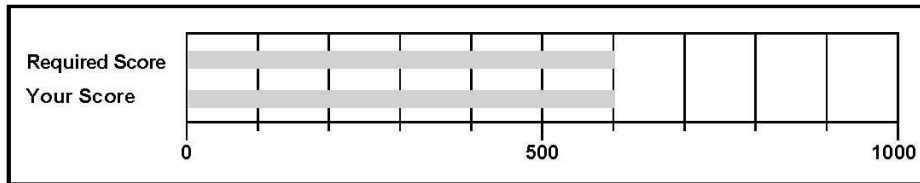
